FIVE (5) AVENUES OF ROTARY SERVICE

Based on the Object of Rotary, we strive to achieve towards our motto “Service Above Self” and commit to serve through FIVE (5) Avenues of Service, which are the foundation of the club activity.

1 Club Service focuses on activities that require Rotarians to participate while fostering the bonding and fellowship in progressing as a healthy, vibrant and sustainable club.

2 Vocational Service opens opportunity to Rotarians to serve others through their vocation to promote integrity and practice high ethical standards.

3 Community Service pertains to those activities the Club undertakes to improve the quality of life in its community and to serve the public interest.

4 International Service compasses those programs and activities undertaken to meet humanitarian needs globally and advance international understanding, goodwill and peace.

5 Youth Service recognizes the importance of empowering youth and young professionals through various leadership development activities and youth exchange programs.

THE OBJECT OF ROTARY is to foster:

- i. The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service;
- ii. High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;
- iii. The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal business and community life;
- iv. The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

ROTARY & POLIO



POLIO or poliomyelitis, is a paralyzing and potentially deadly infectious disease that most commonly affects children under the age of 5. The virus spreads from person to person, typically through contaminated water. It can then attack the nervous system.

Rotary launched its polio immunization program Polio Plus in 1985, and in 1988 became a spearheading partner in **Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI)** with WHO, UNICEF, and US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and later joined by the Bill Melinda Gates Foundation. Our goal of ridding the world of this disease is closer than ever. We have helped to immunize more than 2.5 billion children and reduce polio cases by 99.9 percent. Our work fighting the disease won't stop until polio is gone for good.

“ Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan, Nigeria, and Pakistan. However, in December 2019, the Ministry of Health of Malaysia announced the country's first case of polio since 1992. Testing has confirmed that the virus is genetically linked to poliovirus circulating in the Philippines.

It is crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio-free. If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year. ”

Polio PLUS

The “Plus” is something else that is provided as part of the polio eradication campaign that helps improving lives. GPEI ensures populations reached for polio campaigns are also able to access much needed basic services, such as clean water, sanitation and nutrition which reduces rate of disease. GPEI also provides skills training programs and create jobs that are uniquely suited to polio survivors; educating others about the effects of the disease.

Polio Plus Grants have built an infrastructure for delivering health care and collecting data which help building a stronger health system that provides better access to lifesaving interventions for the world's most vulnerable children.

CORONAVIRUS COVID-19

As the COVID-19 pandemic spreads uncertainty and hardship around the world, Rotary members and participants are innovating, caring for those affected, and showing that even at a distance, there are ways to help.

As people of action, Rotary members are engaged in their communities – gathering for projects and offering help to those in need.

Fighting Disease is one of Rotary's main causes, so members already support efforts to promote proper hand washing techniques, teach people other ways to stay healthy, and supply training and vital medical equipment to health care providers. Now they're helping health authorities communicate lifesaving information about COVID-19

and donating protective gear and other supplies to clinics and hospitals that are under strain because of the pandemic.

The Rotary Foundation (“TRF”) has approved more than \$5 million in Disaster Response Grants to address the COVID-19 pandemic.

Rotary's Statement on COVID-19 and its impact on polio eradication

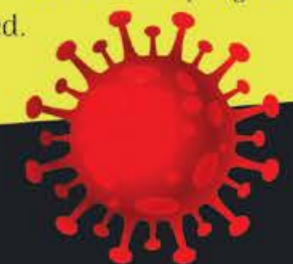
The COVID-19 pandemic response requires worldwide solidarity and an urgent global effort. The GPEI, with thousands of polio workers and an extensive laboratory and surveillance networks, has a moral imperative to ensure that these resources are used to support countries in their preparedness and response.

We can be proud that in the even-connected world of global health, the polio infrastructure that Rotarians have helped build is already being used to address – and stop the spread of – the new coronavirus, in

addition to serving countless other health needs. In Nigeria, Pakistan, and Afghanistan, where polio personnel and assets have a significant presence workers from all GEPI partners are engaged in surveillance, health worker training, contact tracing and more. In 13 countries, polio volunteers have been deployed to address COVID-19 preparations and response.

We recognize that the COVID-19 emergency means that some aspects of the polio eradication program will be affected. While addressing the new challenges

of today, the most important thing that Rotary members can do to continue the fight to end polio is to sustain our commitment. We are aiming to reach our fund raising goal of \$50 million this year so we can work to safely reach all children with the polio vaccine. In the midst of a global pandemic, we understand that attention to polio eradication will be temporarily diverted, and this makes it all the more vital for Rotarians to remain strongly committed to fighting polio and not let our progress be eroded.

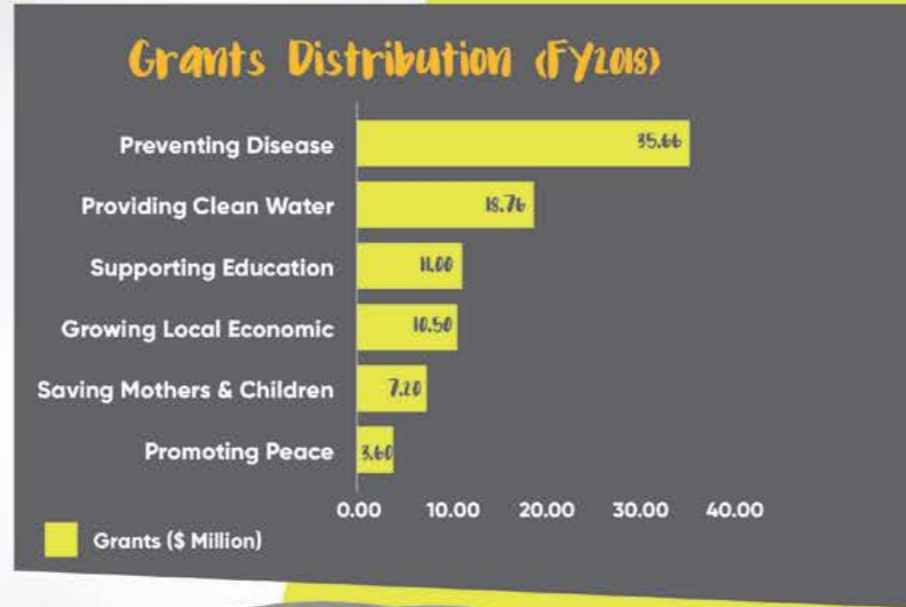


The Rotary Foundation (TRF)

The concert was jointly organized by RKC together with Plaza Merdeka group of companies and The Waterfront Hotel in raising fund to support The Salvation Army's relocation of new site to Kota Samarahan. It was a musical performance cum formal dinner. The concert featured performances by Sainsku Winds Orchestra and South Norfolk Youth Symphonic Band (UK), and contemporary violinist Nisa Addina Taufik. The donations were made by government (RM4.0 mil), Borneo Medical Centre (RM2.6 mil) and through other sponsorships (RM0.25 mil). Previously in 2016, similar concert was organized jointly with Sarawak Heart Foundation to provide financial relief for the lower income individuals requiring cardiovascular procedures.



Rotary Brings Vision to Sarawak: Prevention of Blindness

Prevention of Blindness is one of Rotary's key areas of focus, and hence, 'ROTARY Brings Vision To Sarawak', a preventable blindness campaign (or known as cataract project) has been one of our signature project all these year since 2008.

During Rotary year 2019-2020, RKC has arranged to have 354 cataract operations carried out so far in Kuching, Bau, Serian, Sri Aman and Simunjan for patients from the lower income group. These operations are carried out with assistance from Klinik Katarak 1 Malaysia at no cost to the patients. The total value of the intraocular lens donated for these operations was approximately RM95,000 with the majority of the funds raised through the Rotary Charity Run 2018 - Gift of Sight.

Back To School 4.0

Our annual 'Back to School' programme focuses:

- Providing school kits to students from urban poverty families
- Enhancing awareness of the plight of poor families
- Supporting the education for poor students

Led by Projects Chair Roland Phang, we saw our "Back to School" programme successfully carried out from the month of October 2019 to February 2020, benefiting 1,347 students from 31 schools locating in Miri, Batang Sadong, Serian, Padawan and Samarahan. These students from lower income families were identified with the help of the Education Department. The project is done in collaboration with Yayasan Sime Darby who had a budget of RM 130,000 committed for the supply of uniforms, school bags, shoes, socks and stationaries to these underprivileged students.

The projects involved a budget of approximately RM26,000, working in collaboration with CIMB Foundation and Community Link who funded major portion of the project.

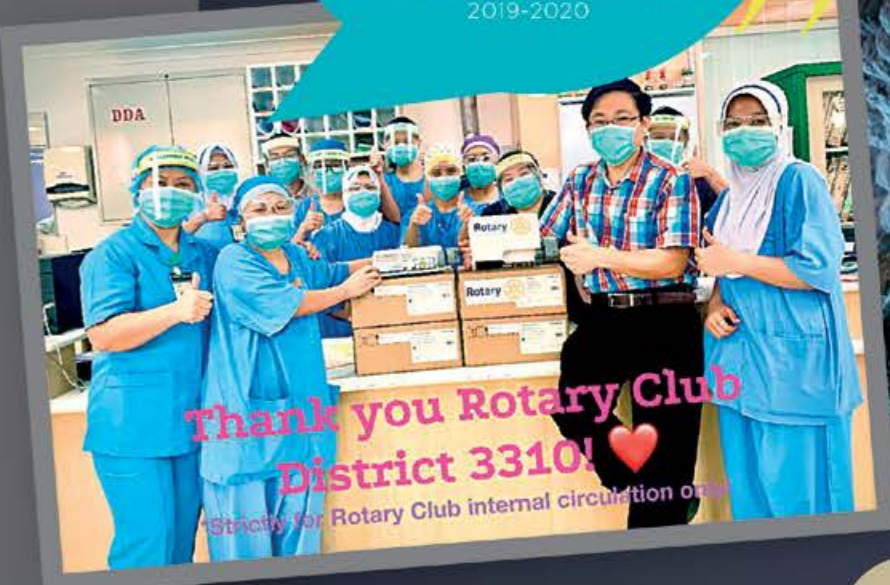

The Rotary clubs in Kuching UNITES to FIGHT against COVID-19. RCKC spearheaded the 'Kuching Unites against Covid-19' project ("KUA Covid-19") with 3 other Rotary clubs in Kuching in response to the Covid-19 pandemic.

This KUA Covid-19 project is led by Advisor PP Ng Yaw Hua, Treasurer PP Dato Thomas Ngu, Team Lead Calvin Chong, Project Chair Roland Phang, RCKC President Leonard Sia, RCK President Larry Ong, RCKS President Andy Lee and RCKJ President Kazue Sakai. The initiative focuses on distributing aids to medical front-liners and food aids to the needy around Kuching.

Various aids distributed to assist medical front-liners of Sarawak General Hospital, namely Pediatric ICU (PICU), Emergency and Trauma Department (ETD), Covid19 ICU, Covid 19 Screening Centre at Kompleks Belia dan Sukan (KBS) and other clinics around Kuching including Klinik Kesihatan Tanah Putih, Klinik Kesihatan Siburan and Pusat Jantung Sarawak.

The total budget for KUA Covid-19, covering medical kits and food donations was approximately RM124,000 and the club is continuing its effort to do more for the Covid-19 situation.

Distribution of Protective & Medical Kits

Throughout April and May 2020, the project group donated more than RM 65,000 worth of various Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) related materials and items to several key wards at the Sarawak General Hospital, government clinics in need, as well as front-liners. Among the various PPEs and items distributed are:

These beneficiaries are based in Kuching and its surrounding areas, and are either squatters, single parent families, low income families, as well as those who lost their daily incomes. Each parcel worth about RM100 per family, containing basic food products with 5 pieces of surgical masks. Total amount spent was approximately RM59,000.

24-hours Fast-Track Event

To further assist and to better protect our medical front-liners in Covid19 ICU at the Sarawak General Hospital, a mini crowd funding was held on 23rd April 2020, 2200 hours to raise funds to purchase 37 units of 3M half faced respirators, 3 units of 3M full faced respirators and one month of filters supply. Friends of Rotary each 'adopted' one medical front-liner at the Covid19 ICU at SGH at a cost of RM305.00 each. At lightning speed, the generosity of 40 friends and family of Rotary and the general public has made this possible swiftly with a total funds of RM14,335.00 raised by 0900 hrs on 24th April 2020. Immediately, these supplies were secured and handed over to Dr. Teo Shu Ching and Dr. Phang Tih Shyang of the Covid19 ICU at SGH by 1600hrs on 24th April 2020. From funding to delivery, completed within 24 hours.
