



Through our Rotary service to humanity, let us make a difference to the world around us which in itself will be an inspiration, not just to our members but to the world and communities involved.



OUR HISTORY





Paul P. Harris, an attorney, wanted to create a professional group with the same friendly spirit he felt in the small towns of his youth. On 23 February 1905, Paul P. Harris, GustavusLoehr, Silvester Schiele and Hiram Shorey gathered at Loehr's office in Room 711 of the Unity Building in downtown Chicago. This was the first Rotary Club Meeting. They decided to call the new club "Rotary" after the practice of rotating meeting locations. Within five years clubs had formed across the country, from San Francisco to New York.

In August 1910, Rotarians held their first convention in Chicago. The 16 clubs that existed at that time united to form the National Association of Rotary Clubs. In 1912, the name changed to International Association of Rotary Clubs to reflect the addition of clubs in other countries. The name Rotary International was adopted in 1922. By July 1925, Rotary had grown to more than 2,000 clubs and an estimated 108,000 members on six continents.

As Rotary grew, members pooled their resources and used their talents to serve the communities. The organisation dedication to this ideal is best expressed in its motto "SERVICE ABOVE SELF".

POLIO or poliomyelitis, is a paralyzing and potentially deadly infectious disease that most commonly affects children under the age of 5. The virus spreads from person to person, typically through contaminated water. It can then attack the nervous system.


Rotary launched its polio immunization program Polio Plus in 1985, and in 1988 became a spearheading partner in Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI) with WHO, UNICEF, and US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. While polio cases have fallen 99.9% since 1988, polio remains a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) and persistent barriers to reaching every child with polio vaccines and the pandemic have contributed to an increase in polio cases. Last year, 1226 cases of all forms of polio were recorded compared to 138 in 2018.

In 2020, the GPEI paused polio door-to-door campaigns for four months to protect communities from the spread of COVID-19 and contributed up to 30,000 programme staff and over \$100 million in polio resources to support pandemic response in almost 50 countries. GPEI will be launching the *Polio Eradication Strategy 2022-2026: Delivering on a Promise*, to overcome the remaining challenges to ending polio, including setbacks caused by COVID-19.

POLIO PLUS······

The "Plus" in PolioPLUS is something else that is provided as part of the polio eradication campaign that helps improving lives. GPEI ensures populations reached for polio campaigns are also able to access much needed basic services, such as clean water, sanitation and nutrition which reduces rate of disease. GPEI also provides skills training programs and create jobs that are uniquely suited to polio survivors; educating others about the effects of the disease.








THE ROTARY **FOUNDATION (TRF)**




2020-21 ROTARY CITATION




INDUCTION **OF NEW MEMBERSHIPS**

There were about 1400 pieces of assorted clothing items and 500 pieces of face masks distributed to the longhouse residents in Julau, which is approximately 385KM away from Kuching. Despite the tiring drive of more than 10 hours, RCKC members were in high spirit of rendering assistance for this very first Service Project of the year.

The clothing items were contributed by UNIQLO Malaysia (through their Uniqlo Recycle Campaign) as well as Kuching Marathon where both have prior records of working jointly with RCKC. We hope our little act of support can partially ease their basic needs while awaiting authority's efforts in rebuilding their home.
