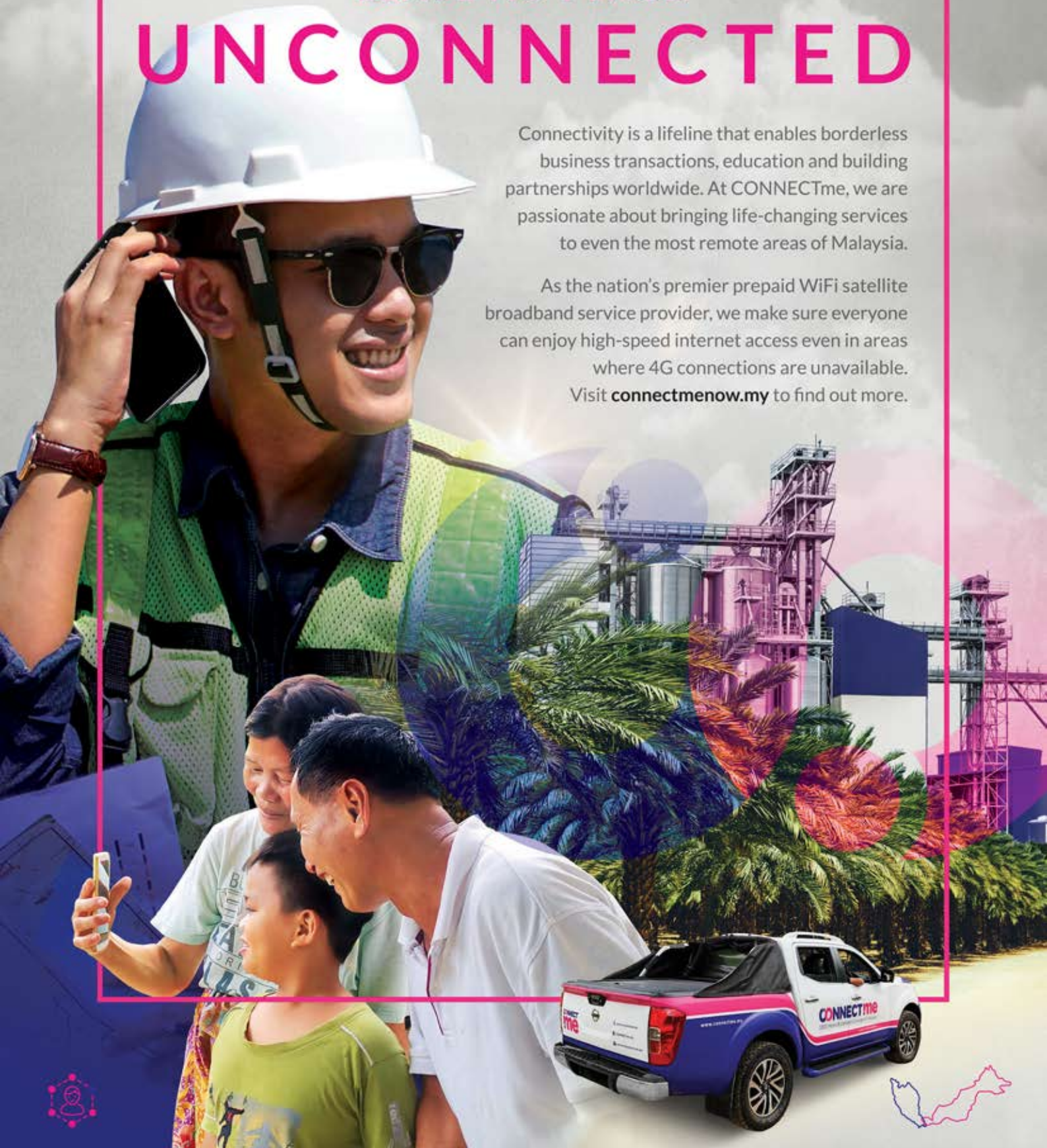

## OUR HISTORY



Paul P. Harris, an attorney, wanted to create a professional group with the same friendly spirit he felt in the small towns of his youth. On 23 February 1905, Paul P. Harris, Gustavus Loehr, Silvester Schiele and Hiram Shorey gathered at Loehr's office in Room 711 of the Unity Building in downtown Chicago. This was the first Rotary Club Meeting. They decided to call the new club "Rotary" after the practice of rotating meeting locations. Within five years clubs had formed across the country, from San Francisco to New York.

In August 1910, Rotarians held their first convention in Chicago. The 16 clubs that existed at that time united to form the National Association of Rotary Clubs. In 1912, the name changed to International Association of Rotary Clubs to reflect the addition of clubs in other countries. The name Rotary International was adopted in 1922. By July 1925, Rotary had grown to more than 2,000 clubs and an estimated 108,000 members on six continents.

As Rotary grew, members pooled their resources and used their talents to serve the communities. The organisation's dedication to this ideal is best expressed in its motto "SERVICE ABOVE SELF".

The development of acquaintance as an opportunity for service

2

High ethical standards in business and professions; the recognition of the worthiness of all useful occupations; and the dignifying of each Rotarian's occupation as an opportunity to serve society;

The application of the ideal of service in each Rotarian's personal, business, and community life;

4

The advancement of international understanding, goodwill, and peace through a world fellowship of business and professional persons united in the ideal of service.

# END POLIO NOW

POLIO or poliomyelitis, is a paralyzing and potentially deadly infectious disease that most commonly affects children under the age of 5. The virus spreads from person to person, typically through contaminated water. It can then attack the nervous system.

Rotary launched its polio immunization program Polio Plus in 1985, and in 1988 became a spearheading partner in Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI) with WHO, UNICEF, and US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention. While polio cases have fallen 99.9% since 1988, polio remains a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) and persistent barriers to reaching every child with polio vaccines and the pandemic have contributed to an increase in polio cases. Last year, 1226 cases of all forms of polio were recorded compared to 138 in 2018.

In 2020, the GPEI paused polio door-to-door campaigns for four months to protect communities from the spread of COVID-19 and contributed up to 30,000 programme staff and over \$100 million in polio resources to support pandemic response in almost 50 countries. GPEI will be launching the *Polio Eradication Strategy 2022-2026: Delivering on a Promise*, to overcome the remaining challenges to ending polio, including setbacks caused by COVID-19.

## POLIO PLUS

The "Plus" in PolioPLUS is something else that is provided as part of the polio eradication campaign that helps improving lives. GPEI ensures populations reached for polio campaigns are also able to access much needed basic services, such as clean water, sanitation and nutrition which reduces rate of disease. GPEI also provides skills training programs and create jobs that are uniquely suited to polio survivors; educating others about the effects of the disease.

Health workers and volunteers supported PolioPlus Grants have built an infrastructure for delivering health care and collecting data that, in many world didn't exist before. It's already being used to improve overall health care and fight other diseases, proving that the legacy of PolioPlus is more than eradicating a deadly disease from the planet - it's also building a stronger health system that provides better access to lifesaving interventions for the world's most vulnerable children.

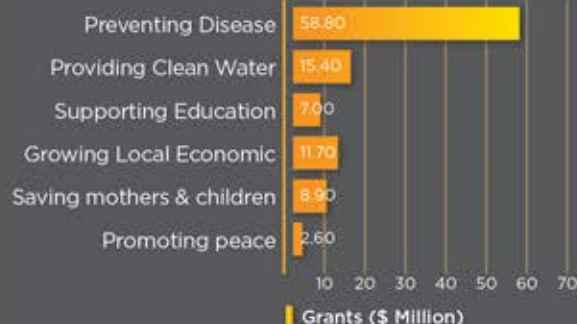


## THE ROTARY FOUNDATION (TRF)

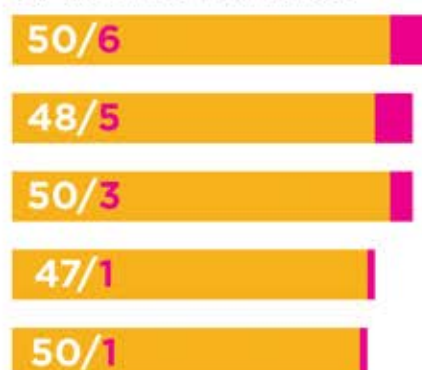

## CLOTHING ITEMS FOR THE FIRE VICTIMS IN JULAU

140 people were left homeless after an afternoon fire razed their 20-Doors Rumah Chat Longhouse at Julau. Almost the entire 20-door longhouse was destroyed with all victims temporarily squatting at a chapel nearby.

The handover trip was led by President Chen Yi and Service Project Chair, Rtn Calvin Chong, with 4 other Rotarians to help transporting the items. There were about 1400 pieces of assorted clothing items and 500 pieces of face masks distributed to the longhouse residents in Julau, which is approximately 385KM away from Kuching. Despite the tiring drive of more than 10 hours, RCKC members were in high spirit of rendering assistance for this very first Service Project of the year.

The clothing items were contributed by UNIQLO Malaysia (through their Uniqlo Recycle Campaign) as well as Kuching Marathon where both have prior records of working jointly with RCKC. We hope our little act of support can partially ease their basic needs while awaiting authority's efforts in rebuilding their home.

## Rotary Maryland Gives Succor to Ososa Residents

Monday June 28 this year will remain a remarkable day for residents of Ososa in Ogun State, who witnessed the unveiling of a fully equipped medical portacabin at the Ososa Primary Healthcare Centre in the state.

This medical intervention project was powered by Rotary Club of Maryland, Lagos in partnership with the Ogun State government, Rotary Club of Kuching Central District 3320, and Rotary Club of Singapore District 3310.

For the young and old in Ososa, this health cabin will prevent maternal and child morbidity and mortality as well as treat and prevent diseases. The President, Rotary Club of Maryland, Rotarian Chafem Obadina, expressed: "I'm quite excited because the project is going to touch so many lives possible."

Apart from donating it, the club also furnished the cabin with the necessary equipment. Obadina emphasised, "It's going to save a lot of lives, reduce maternal and child death, and it will treat and prevent a lot

of diseases." The commissioning of the project falls under two areas of focus of Rotary. They include disease prevention and treatment, and also enhance maternal and child health.

"As you are aware, this is a community that has a lot of elderly people. The elderly people need basic healthcare to sustain their health, so they will have access to healthcare from this portacabin we donated."

"We did not just donate the project, it's in collaboration with the Ogun State government Ministry of Health, who will ensure sustainability and maintenance of the project going forward."

"Before the donation of the project, Rotary Club of Maryland carried out a needs assessment. Consequently, they understood that Ososa women didn't have access to ant and prenatal services and some of them give birth in their homes. 'We all know it's not ideal,' Obadina frowned.

Following the assessment, the club pledged to bridge the gap to accessing healthcare service, hence, the commissioning of the cabin.

In his reaction, the Cooptee of Ososa-Iyebu, Oba (Dr) Adeyemi

Alatibe, expressed gratitude to God and the club. "It's a fantastic project, not just in line with my profession as a medical doctor, but in line with our aspiration and vision for our people."

Alatibe described Ososa known as formerly laid-back, slippery and majesty agrarian in nature. "Since we came here, we have been having a series of

developments not just because our sons and daughters in the diaspora are giving back to the community, but because the government also recognises some of the things we have been doing."

"We are hoping that a number of things like that will continue to come to our community. The next thing we need is a laboratory," while assuring the club that they would take care of the portacabin. "We will make the best use of it."

The health portacabin, which is fully equipped to run operations immediately comprises a consulting room, observation room, laboratory, bathroom and a toilet. It is meant to support the work of the Ososa PHC, as an outpatient unit.

Others present at the commissioning included the Special Adviser to Ogun State Governor on Health, Dr Tayo Lawal, representing the Commissioner for Health Ogun State, Dr. Tami Coker; and the Executive Secretary, Ogun State PHC Development Board, Dr. Eljah Ogunbadehin among others.
