ROTARY IN BRIEF: ROTARY & POLIO

POLIO or poliomyelitis, is a paralyzing and potentially deadly infectious disease that most commonly affects children under the age of 5. The virus spreads from person to person, typically through contaminated water. It can then attack the nervous system, and in some instances, lead to paralysis.

Rotary launched its polio immunization program Polio Plus in 1985, and in 1988 became a spearheading partner in Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI) with WHO, UNICEF, and US Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and later joined by the Bill Melinda Gates Foundation. While polio cases have fallen 99.9% since 1988, polio remains a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC) and persistent barriers to reaching every child with polio vaccines and pandemic have contributed to an increase in polio cases.

In 2020, the GPEI paused polio door-to-door campaigns for four months to protect communities from the spread of COVID-19 and contributed up to 30,000 programme staff and over \$100million in polio resources to support pandemic response in almost 50 countries.

“Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan and Pakistan. But it’s crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio-free. If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year.”

POLIO PLUS

The “Plus” is something else that is provided as part of the polio eradication campaign that helps improve lives. GPEI ensures populations reached for polio campaigns are also able to access much needed basic services, such as clean water, sanitation and nutrition, which reduces the rate of disease. Apart from educating others about the effects of the disease, GPEI also provides skill training programs and creates jobs that are uniquely suited to polio survivors.

Polio Plus Grants have built an infrastructure for delivering healthcare and collecting data which help build a stronger health system that provides better access to lifesaving interventions for the world’s most vulnerable children.

5 SUPPORTING EDUCATION

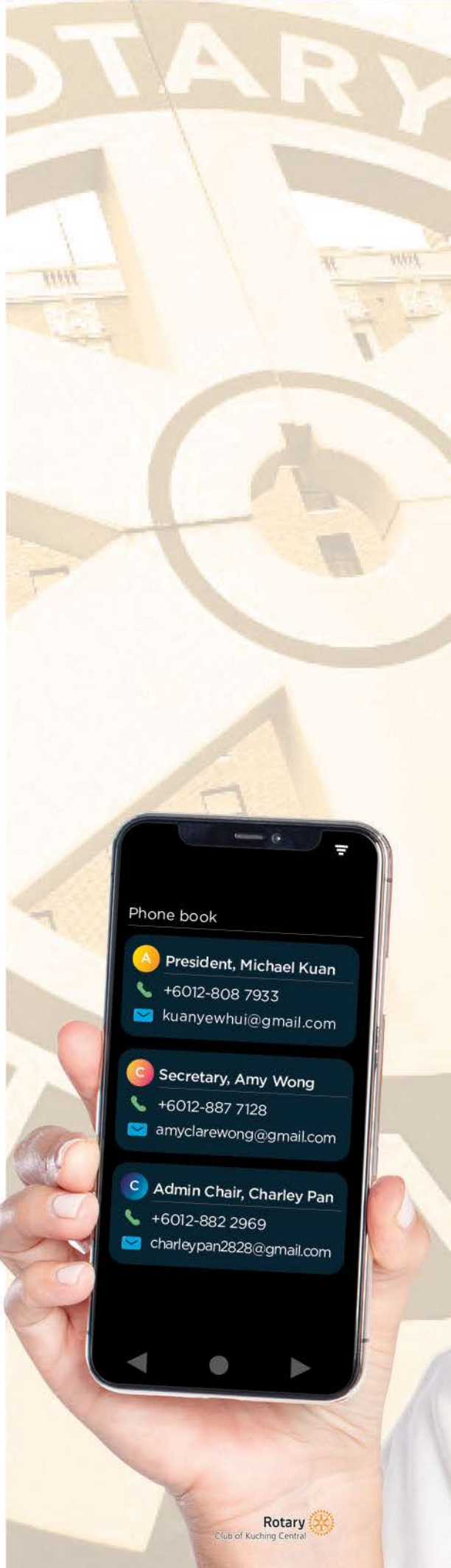

Introduction to Rotary Club of Kuching Central



The Rotary Club of Kuching Central (RCKC) was formed on 23rd December 1986 with Chua Teck Kheng as the Chartered President for the Rotary year 1986-87. 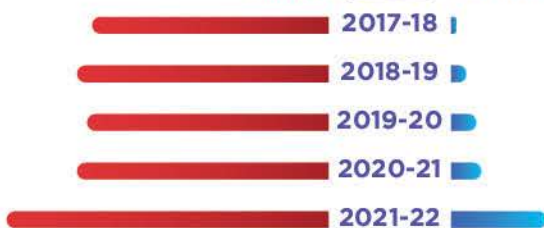

Membership Trends

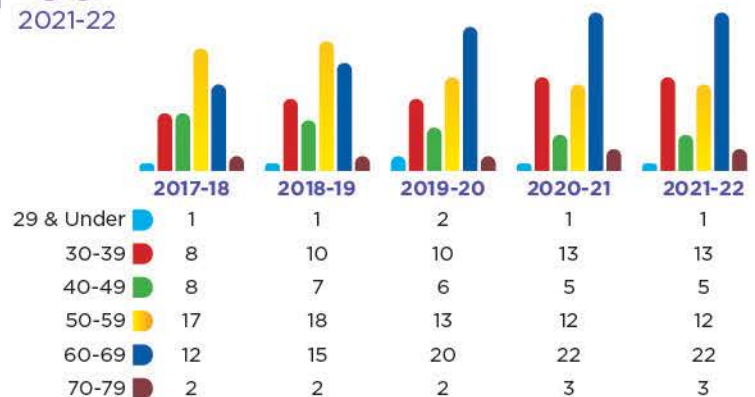


Gender Trends

The Rotary End Polio Now Hole-in-One Charity Drive 2021 was launched on 12 November 2021 by YB Dato Sri Abdul Karim Rahman Hamzah and ran from 12 November to 12 December 2021. This is the first ever EPN golf fund-raising event in Rotary International District 3310.

With each golfer contributing RM10 per regular round of golf (9/18 holes) to be eligible for the hole-in-one attempt at the selected holes, RCKC managed to raise a total of RM14,670.00. The funds raised from this charity drive will be channeled to the End Polio Now (EPN) fund of Rotary International to eradicate polio globally. DELIVERY OF MILK FORMULA TO NEEDY FAMILIES IN KUCHING

JOINT COVID-19 GRANT PROJECT WITH RAC SWINBURNE

A simple handover of 1377 packs of sanitary pads to SMK Tarat was carried out as part of the District 3310 Covid-19 joint project with RAC Swinburne on the 4th of April 2022. 'Women and feminine hygiene' is an area that is often overlooked. Financially stressed B40 households that are suffering from reduced income due to the economic impact of the pandemic are likely to forgo purchases of proper sanitary pads for the female members with younger ones most at risk. Their scarce financial resources are likely to be directed towards food items rather than peripheral necessities. Thanks to the District Covid-19 grant and the assistance of Sarawak Women for Women society, we were able to provide much needed support for these females during this difficult period. We hope to continue to #ServeToChangeLives, especially for those who are often sidelined in society.

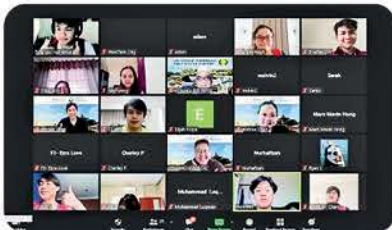
Sunday, 12th September
