



Rotary members are people of action. We don't wait for change to happen; we make it happen. And what do people of action do? We unite for good.



## ROTARY IN BRIEF: ROTARY & POLIO

"Today, polio remains endemic only in Afghanistan and Pakistan. But it's crucial to continue working to keep other countries polio-free. If all eradication efforts stopped today, within 10 years, polio could paralyze as many as 200,000 children each year."

POLIO or poliomyelitis, is a paralyzing and potentially deadly infectious disease that most commonly affects children under the age of 5. People can contract the virus from one another by drinking contaminated water. The nervous system may then be attacked, which occasionally results in paralysis.

A founding participant in the Global Polio Eradication Initiative (GPEI) alongside WHO, UNICEF, the US Centres for Disease Control and Prevention, and later joined by the Bill Melinda Gates Foundation, Rotary launched its polio vaccination programme Polio Plus in 1985. Despite the fact that polio cases have decreased by 99.9% since 1988, the disease still constitutes a Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC), and ongoing challenges to providing every kid with polio immunisations and the pandemic have increased the number of cases.

In 2020, the GPEI paused polio door-to-door campaigns for four months to protect communities from the spread of COVID-19 and contributed up to 30,000 programme staff and over \$100million in polio resources to support pandemic response in almost 50 countries.

## **ROTARY PLUS**

The "Plus" is something else that is provided as part of the polio eradication campaign that helps improve lives. GPEI ensures populations reached for polio campaigns are also able to access much needed basic services, such as clean water, sanitation and nutrition, which reduces the rate of disease. Apart from educating others about the effects of the disease, GPEI also provides skill training programs and creates jobs that are uniquely suited to polio survivors.

Polio Plus Grants have built an infrastructure for delivering healthcare and collecting data which help build a stronger health system that provides better access to lifesaving interventions for the world's most vulnerable children.







# **Gift of Sight**

In this Rotary year, a total of 225 free cataract operations under the club's signature project 'Gift of Sight' were carried out for the lower-income beneficiaries in Sri Aman, Simunjan, Bau, Serian and Lundu. This saw the club working together with the Malaysian Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints to provide the required intraocular lenses for the beneficiaries, identified through the preliminary screenings at the various district hospitals. Besides showing support for the patients waiting for their turn, club members also distributed food parcels courtesy of PP Frankie Ong and Borneo Biscuits Factory.

The club also collaborated with the Ophthalmology department of the Sarawak General Hospital for the World Sight Day 2024 event at the Bau District Hospital. In addition to the cataract operations then, eye and health screenings, children's colouring contest, as well as various awareness talks were held to further spread awareness of the importance of eye health amongst the general population, especially for the children in line with this year's theme 'Eyes for the Future'.

The club hopes to continue alleviating Sarawak's backlog of patients in need of cataract outings as we believe that no one should lose their sight due to cataract because of money.



































# Gift of Education | 12 October 2024

The Rotary Club of Kuching Central had the privilege of donating STEM educational materials to three primary schools in need. The schools benefiting from this initiative were SJK(C) Sungai Apong, SK Sungai Stutong, and SK Pangkalan Kuap. This project was made possible through a collaboration with UiTM and the generous support of their sponsor, TnJ Engineering. As part of the effort, UiTM also provided training for teachers on how to effectively use the new materials and assessed their impact. The pre and post-test results showed significant improvement in the students' STEM scores, clearly demonstrating how the students' learning experience was enhanced.

It is hoped that their performance will continue to grow positively. RCKC remains committed to supporting education and literacy, and this project is just one of many similar initiatives the club plans to pursue in the future.











# Save Trees Save Life | 26 October 2024

On 26th October 2024, the "Save Trees, Save Life" program took place, led by RC Kuching Jaya and joined by all Rotary Clubs in Kuching. The event garnered 200 participants, with District Governor Dr. Yap Lip Kee as the guest of honour. Collaborating with the Rotaract Club of Swinburne Sarawak, Rotaract Club of Segi, Rotaract Club of UNIMAS, and the Interact Clubs of SMK Bandar Kuching No.1 and St Teresa, the group succeeded in planting 900 trees at the Sabal Forest Reserve.

This initiative was a powerful example of community teamwork, contributing to environmental conservation and raising awareness about the importance of protecting green spaces. The success of the event reflects our ongoing commitment in promoting sustainability and combating climate change.











# CSSC - Uniqlo Clothes of Love | 13 July 2024

The Clothes of Love distribution was organised in collaboration with Uniqlo Malaysia at the Kuching Community Social Support Centre (CSSC). Approximately 120 beneficiaries from the urban poor, identified by CSSC, selected clothing for themselves or their families, with assistance from 32 volunteers from RCKC, Uniqlo, CSSC, and the Sarawak CSO-SDG Alliance. Each beneficiary also received a food parcel.

The clothes, donated through Uniqlo's RE.Uniqlo programme, were sorted and packed by Uniqlo staff and RCKC members. The initiative aimed to ease the recipients' burdens and promote sustainable clothing reuse. RCKC looks forward to more future collaborations with Uniqlo.

Upon their arrival at Kampung Mapu Tantu, the members were warmly greeted by the residents. President Roland delivered a speech in fluent Bahasa Malaysia, explaining the project, while the symbolic handover was witnessed by YB Martin Ben. The event was followed by a feast of local delicacies, home cooked by the villagers and catered by the club. In true Sarawakian festive style, the celebration continued with dancing and fun for all.

RCKC hopes that their small efforts bring joy to the villagers and that the clothes can help ease some of their economic burden and give them confidence.















# Uniqlo Clothes of Love for SOS Kids | 13 & 15 Dec 2024

To spread the Magic of Rotary this festive season, the RCKC x Uniqlo Clothes of Love project partnered with SOS Kids, benefiting 87 critically ill children and their families. RCKC members personally delivered donated items and learned about the families' situations.

Uniqlo Malaysia donated 325 pieces of brand new Airism clothing as part of their 'Heart of LifeWear' initiative and 100 sets of coloring pencils, while DHL assisted with the shipping. Our RCKC family raised a total of RM6350 to purchase a portable suction machine for SOS Kids and 87 food sets from the children's wish list. PP Frankie Ong and Rtn Philip Au Yong also contributed biscuits and noodles. In addition, Rotarians wrote festive postcards to include with the gifts.

Thanks to everyone who contributed, and to President Alaric of the Rotary Club of KL DiRaja for coordinating the shipment. We hope others are inspired to share their joy with those in need, especially during festive seasons.















# Borneo Flood Relief - Serian Division | 19 February 2025

In response to the devastating floods in Serian Division, the Rotary Club of Kuching Central, Rotary Club of Kuching, Malaysian Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints, and Rotaract Clubs of Swinburne Sarawak and SEGi Sarawak launched the 'Borneo Flood Relief - Serian Division, Sarawak' project.

After a survey and discussions with President Roland of RCKC, local authorities, and villagers, it was identified that mattresses and pillows were urgently needed. With support from Rotary clubs in District 3310, the initiative provided 516 mattresses and 1,032 pillows to affected families, in addition to the 100 boxes of clothing from Uniqlo Malaysia, 20 boxes of sanitary pads, and portable cooking stoves distributed in the first week.

A symbolic handover of the items took place at the Service Sarawak Centre in Serian, with the distribution at the respective villages carried out later. Led by Organising Chair Rtn Sharon Chua of RCKC, this collaborative effort highlights the strength of community support in times of crisis.

















# Rotary Hydrates for Education | 27 February 2025

The "Rotary Hydrates for Education" project was carried out in collaboration with the Rotary Club of Taipei Golden Eagle, Taiwan, and the Rotary Club of Queenstown, Singapore. The initiative involved the donation of a concrete plinth and the transportation of two 25,000-liter water tanks from SK Jangkar to SK Kendaie in Lundu.

This project, launched during IPP Calvin's term and completed in the current Rotary year, addresses the critical water shortages faced by SK Kendaie during the dry season. The new water tanks will ensure a reliable water supply, improving the learning environment for the students.

Special thanks go to all the partners and contributors, particularly Safewater Asia Sdn Bhd, for their generosity in providing the installation and piping works free of charge. This collaborative effort highlights the true spirit of Rotary and the power of community teamwork in creating positive change.











# Clean Water Filtration System project | 9 April 2025

The Rotary Club of Kuching Central handed over clean water systems for 10 primary schools in the Lundu area, benefiting over 1200 students and staff. This Clean Water Filtration System project was a collaboration with the Malaysian Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints and Safewater Asia Sdn Bhd. A simple handover for all schools was conducted at SK Holy Name.

The systems provided are simple to use and maintain, and would provide the school and students a reliable source of clean water up to several years while waiting for a longer-term solution from the government. This would help to alleviate the beneficiaries' and their parents' concerns about water-borne diseases and their children's health. This could also help reduce the burden on the local water system.

Water, sanitation and health remains one of RCKC's areas of focus and we look to carry out more meaningful projects like these through the Magic of Rotary.











# RCKC's Joint Project with Friendship Club RC Guia of District 3450 | 12 March 2025

As part of RCKC's joint project with their Friendship club RC Guia of District 3450, 20 sets of benches were donated to Klinik Kesihatan Tebakang. This would provide seating for 80 patients and visitors, bringing them some needed comfort and accessibility as they wait their turn at the clinic, which is 1 hour outside of Kuching and only recently completed its renovations.

A simple handover was carried out with President Roland, PE Pauline, and Organising Chair Rtn Amy in attendance with staff from the clinic. This project is part of our reciprocal agreement with RC Guia to strengthen our bonds of friendship while making a meaningful impact on the local community.

It is hoped that this will lead to many more joint events together in the spirit of international friendship and cooperation through the Magic of Rotary.





# Heart Safe Kuching Launch | 3 Dec 2024

On 3 December 2024, the Rotary Club of Kuching Central (RCKC), the Rotary Club of Singapore East (RCSE), and the Kuching South City Council (MBKS) officially launched the "Heart Safe City Kuching" initiative to enhance public health and safety. A Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) was signed this morning, officiated by Deputy Premier YB Datuk Amar Dr. Sim Kui Hian, marking the start of a pilot project aimed at improving cardiovascular emergency preparedness.

The first Automated External Defibrillator (AED) was installed at the Friendship Park while the other four would be installed at high-traffic locations, including Stutong Market, Kenyalang Market, MBKS Headquarters, and the Indoor Stadium. These devices are vital during cardiac emergencies and aim to save lives.

RCKC, supported by RCSE, has procured and donated the AEDs, while MBKS oversees approvals, installation, and maintenance. Public workshops and awareness campaigns will promote emergency readiness.

This pilot is the first step towards a broader vision to expand AED coverage citywide, ensuring greater access to lifesaving resources for Kuching residents. RCKC extends its gratitude to the Mayor of Kuching South, YBhg Datuk Wee Hong Seng, for his unwavering support in making this initiative a reality.

















# Heart Safe Kuching - Completion of First Phase | 23 April 2025

The Rotary Club of Kuching Central (RCKC) has successfully completed the first phase of the Heart Safe City Kuching initiative, in collaboration with the Rotary Club of Singapore East (RCSE) and the Kuching South City Council (MBKS). This phase saw the installation of Automated External Defibrillators (AEDs) at five high-traffic public locations: Stutong Market, Taman Sahabat, Kenyalang Park Market, MBKS Sports Hall, and MBKS Building.

The event, held at Stutong Market, featured Organising Chair Rtn Delia, who outlined the objectives of the joint project. Kuching South Mayor Datuk Wee Hong Seng expressed gratitude to RCKC and RCSE for their initiative, emphasizing the importance of proper AED usage and first aid techniques. He highlighted that the accessibility of these devices could be life-saving during emergencies.

Moving forward, the project will next focus on training relevant personnel at these locations, as well as interested members of the public, on the correct usage of AEDs and basic life-saving techniques. RCKC is also exploring ways to further enhance the Heart Safe Initiative to benefit more members of the community.




### 74 Years of Service: Rotary Club of Johor Bahru (1952-2025) Chartered: June 27, 1952
